Since Blazin' Brigade is a university course, everyone must sign up for the class. Additional information is available in the class registration guide later in this packet. Take this information when you see your advisor. If you have questions, please contact the band office immediately!

Purchase additional items you will need:

<u>Woodwinds and brass will need to furnish your own lyre and flip folder with at least 20 sheets</u>. *Brass: we do NOT use flip folders or lyres that mount onto our instruments.* You should be able to purchase these through your local music store. Percussion will provide your own three-ring binder with plastic page protectors.

Early dorm move-in: <u>Sunday, August 11, 2024</u>

When you fill out the online registration form, please check **"Yes"** if you will be living in a dorm this fall and will need to move in before band camp (most freshman).

Housing will contact you directly with your housing information and specific move-in times.

A Reminder that during all camps, meals are on your own. Please be sure to check the campus dining hall and Student Union hours for details.

- Additional information on dietary or medical concerns we should know about

If your information changes, you can contact the director or correct it at Band Camp when you check-in.

CLASS REGISTRATION GUIDE

Blazin' Brigade is a University course and **all members of Blazin' Brigade must register for MUSC 3880.** Speak with your advisor about making sure Blazin' Brigade is on your schedule. If any questions arise, please do not hesitate to contact us! A reminder that instrumental music majors (excluding string players) receiving a *Bachelor of Arts* or those who are in the *Music Education Track* are *required* to take marching band for <u>four</u> semesters. This is not negotiable as it is part of the degree requirements approved by NASM for graduation. Any deviation will delay your graduation eligibility and completion date.

Register as soon as possible! Incoming students will register during summer orientation. Please attend the earliest orientation session you can; you will have a better opportunity to take the classes you want/need at the times that are most convenient for you.

CLASS CONFLICTS

Class conflicts are handled on a case-by-case basis. If the conflicting class is an elective or offered another semester, it does not qualify for you to receive an exemption. Any course that overlaps more that 15 minutes of rehearsal does not qualify for exemption.

Work, Club Events, Greek Life, Vacation, etc., conflicts are not excused absences. By joining Blazin' Brigade, you have committed yourself to be a part of one of the most valued traditions at Valdosta State University. You will have opportunities not available to other students.
